

At the beginning of each term we send out these reminders for new and existing families......

#### START & END OF THE DAY

The school bell goes at 8.55am. If you arrive in the playground after the classes have gone in you **must** sign your child in at Reception. This is for safeguarding reasons. At the end of the day parents will have access to the playground via the front gate at 3.15pm and the back gate at 3.20pm.

Dogs are not permitted on the school premises.

#### **BIKES & SCOOTERS**

Children must not ride their bikes & scooters on the playground and must have a permit. These are issued on a first come first served basis. Forms are available from the school office – checks will be in place from Monday.

#### **CLUBS**

Children who stay for after school clubs need to be able to change into their PE kit independently. Due to safeguarding, parents will not be permitted in the areas children are changing.

When collecting children after a school club we ask that parents wait in the playground until the children are sent out.

The car park at school is only for staff, school visitors and school deliveries. Parents and carers must find other parking. There is a rear entrance to the school which is close to Bury Dyke. All pedestrians must use the pedestrian entrance to the school and not cross the car park.
