Free school meals

If you think you might be eligible for free school meals for your child or children please do register with Northamptonshire County Council. This registration provides extra funding to help us support you child or children in school but is only available following registration.

This includes all Key Stage 1 and Foundation Stage children even though they are automatically entitled to a free meal, the school will only receive the extra funds if registration is completed.

Am I entitled?

Children may be entitled to free school meals if you or your partner are in receipt of certain benefits. Your child must attend school on a full-time basis.

Your child will be eligible for Free School Meals if you or your partner receive either:

- Income Support
- Income based Job Seekers Allowance
- Child Tax Credit, with no element of Working Tax Credit*, and a household income below £16,190 (as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs)
- National Asylum Seekers Support
- Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance

*Please note: If you have recently stopped working, or have reduced your working hours to less than 16 per week, and are receiving a four week run-on of Working Tax Credit payments, you can apply for Free School Meals for four weeks, at the commencement of the run-on period.

How does the school know if I am entitled?

An online checking system, provided by the Department for Education, is used to process applications. This system links with your benefit provider and confirms whether or not you are eligible for Free School Meals. It does not provide us with any other information. Your eligibility will be reviewed on a regular basis; however, you must inform us of any change in circumstances as soon as possible.
