SEVERE WEATHER POLICY

In case of snow or icy road conditions the school will try to remain open for pupils.

In the event of closure, a text message will be sent; our website will be updated and notification should appear on Northamptonshire County Council's website under the School Closures section.

If parents decide that it is not safe or practical for their child to attend school, we ask that they contact the School Office.

Children may be collected from school early if parents feel this is appropriate.

Winter Illness & School Attendance

In order to minimise the risk of transmission of illness to other children and staff, please do not bring your child into school

- if your child is showing signs of being unwell
- needs medication, e.g. Calpol, before attending.

We advise parents to keep their children at home if they display any of the following symptoms:

- fever
- vomiting and/or diarrhoea
- headache and chills
- pain in muscles and joints
- sore throat
- coughing
- lack of appetite
- fatigue

Children should not return to school until all symptoms have been absent for a minimum of 24 hours.

A minimum 48 hour absence is advised for vomiting and diarrhoea.
