Message to parents and carers:

Northamptonshire Police have launched a high-profile county-wide campaign this month, to raise awareness of child sexual exploitation (CSE).

The purpose of the campaign is to let the public know the signs children exhibit when they are being subjected to this type of abuse, and to give people guidance about what to do if they come across these signs. For this reason, the campaign is called SAY SOMETHING IF YOU SEE SOMETHING.

You will see the campaign visuals displayed prominently across the county, there will be radio advertising and in addition your child might come across the visuals while online, as there is a three-month digital media campaign supporting the campaign.

Our aim is to raise awareness in young people and parents so they can make informed choices. It is not intended to scare but to prepare them to be able to identify and then risk assess possible dangers they may encounter both on-line and socially.
