I know that parking is limited around our school but I would ask that you please respect the residents who live nearby.

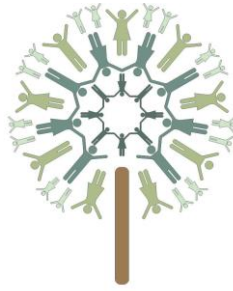
