We have recently subscribed to Purple Mash, which is a creative educational website for children. Purple Mash is a cross-curricular resource covering Art to Science and all subjects in between. Your child can access Purple Mash from home on a laptop, desktop or a tablet.

Purple Mash is a safe environment that does **not** require any downloading or allow interaction with people online and children **cannot** make any financial transactions. We will be encouraging the children to continue their learning at home and Purple Mash is a great resource for this. Your child will be taught how to use Purple Mash in school and will be able to use it without supervision, but you may want to take a few minutes to explore it yourself so that you can help them with their work.

Purple Mash will be replacing Reading Eggs and Mathletics allowing your child better access to a broader range of activities and topics. E-Safety Parent Workshop-Thursday 5th May-3.45-4.45pm

During the week commencing 2nd May we will be planning an E-Safety Week in school in order to teach and highlight the importance of keeping safe on-line. As part of E-Safety week there will be an interactive workshop and presentation for parents and carers on ways to keep young people safe online. The session will last one hour and will include;

- The importance of being safe using social media
- Reporting online concerns
- Warning signs for online bullying, phishing emails and grooming
- Setting up parental controls and how to use them effectively
- Altering young people on the importance of inappropriate content on the internet and warning signs for people asking for inappropriate content and personal information.
- Information and guidance on your digital footprint.
- Guidance on using online gaming safely and being safe when using chat rooms
