children participating in regular physical activity. The distance of the course is 2k and the event is run every Sunday at 9am.

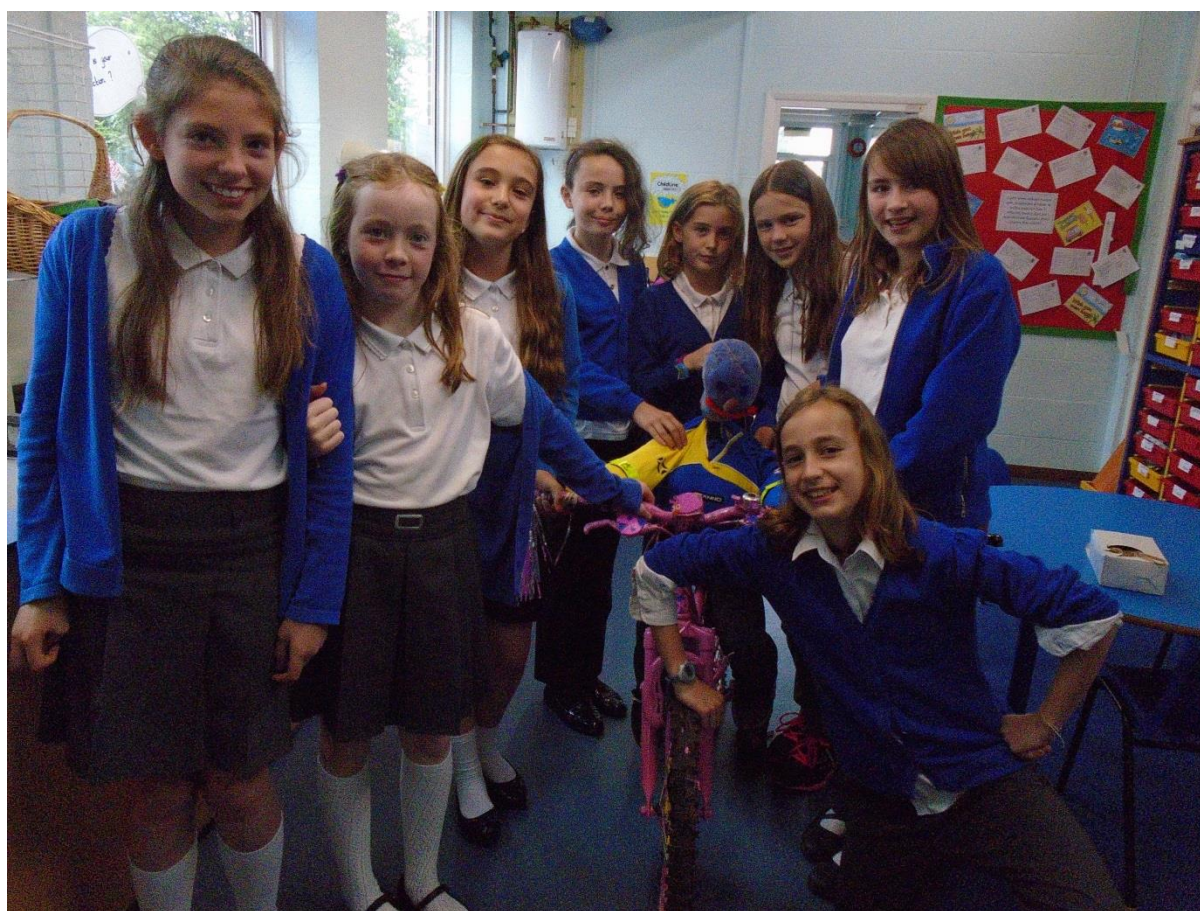
