Pupil Premium Funding

The Government introduced Pupil Premium in April 2011. Pupil premium is additional funding given to publicly funded schools in England to raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils and close the gap between them and their peers. As a school we receive extra funding for children of families who are eligible for free school meals due to being on low income. If you receive income support then please register. Although all children in KS1 are now entitled to a free school meal, pupil premium funding will not be allocated unless you register. It could mean over £1,000 of extra funding per school year for your child which could be spent on school visits, clubs and supporting their learning.
